5. Accelerated Dual Degrees

Accelerated Dual Degree programs (ADDs) combine a Rowan University undergraduate degree with a graduate-level degree. Students typically work on an accelerated track and are also permitted to double-count up to 12 s.h./credits toward both degrees and pay the undergraduate rate for those 12 credits, saving students both time and money as they work toward their educational goals.
